What to do next:

- 1. Make sure you have a fresh installation of WordPress® on your hosting server.
- 2. Once you're logged in, go to **Plugins > Add New.**
- 3. Here, you'll upload the 'BACKUP MIGRATE PLUGIN' file included in your ZIP download.
- 4. Once installed and activated, click on the Seckup Migration in WordPress on the left-hand side.
- 5. Click on the tab that says Manage & Restore Backup(s)
- 6. Click on ★ Upload backup files and choose the file named "WP Ready To Go[™] Child Theme.zip"

7. Once uploaded, it should look like this:
