

Thanks for purchasing the WP Ready To Go™ child theme!

What to do next:

1. Make sure you have a fresh installation of WordPress® on your hosting server.
2. Once you're logged in, go to **Plugins > Add New**.
3. Here, you'll upload the 'BACKUP MIGRATE PLUGIN' file included in your ZIP download.
4. Once installed and activated, click on the  in WordPress on the left-hand side.
5. Click on the tab that says **Manage & Restore Backup(s)**
6. Click on  **Upload backup files** and choose the file named **"WP Ready To Go™ Child Theme.zip"**
7. Once uploaded, it should look like this:




Alternatively, you can place the files (e.g. via FTP) into your local backup directory (/Users/paulcassarly/Local Sites/spiritual-divi-theme-builder-pack/app/public/wp-content/backup-migration-EGfpsFLnxR/backups) or remote storage, and then use the "Rescan for backup files" - option above to make them show up in the list.

8. Click 


9. You will then get this popup. Click the checkbox, then "Start restoring!".



10. Finally, you'll get to this window. You did it! **Press Ok, close**



11. There's one more step. You'll be prompted to log in to your new website. The login details are going to be different than the old WordPress installation you just replaced, so use these credentials:
